- 2 to handle the In Re DePuy cases. Present in front
- 3 of the Court are?
- 4 MS. SHARKO: Susan Sharko from Drinker Biddle
- 5 for the Defense.
- 6 MR. SUDZUS: David Sudzus also from Drinker
- 7 Biddle for Defense.
- 8 MR. FLOWERS: Pete Flowers on behalf of the
- 9 Plaintiffs.
- 10 THE COURT: Okay. What would you like to tell
- 11 the Court, ladies and gentlemen.
- 12 MR. FLOWERS: I think we will start with
- 13 Mr. Sudzus, status of the litigation, as he has
- 14 written here.
- MR. SUDZUS: Your Honor, what we did, as we
- 16 generally do, is we submitted just a list of
- 17 pending cases that we are aware of at the end of
- 18 last week and currently there is 367 pending cases
- 19 before you.
- 20 With respect to the general status of
- 21 those cases and everything else, I think Item No. 2
- 22 on the agenda is probably more relevant than any
- 23 activity in any individual case. So, with that, I
- 24 will turn it over to Mr. Flowers and Ms. Sharko.

Page 7 1 THE COURT: One second. Okay. Whenever you 2. are ready. 3 MS. SHARKO: On November 19 we announced the 4 U.S. settlement program. Your Honor participated 5 by video in the hearing with the federal judge and 6 the other state court judges. We are very grateful 7 for the time and assistance you gave us in helping 8 put this program together and we are now in the 9 process of getting it up and running. 10 THE COURT: Okay. 11 MR. FLOWERS: And, your Honor, as you're 12 aware, there is a website that actually defines a 13 lot of the parameters of the program. 14 It's a private program. 15 essentially an opt-in program that involves anyone 16 that's been revised as of August 31 of 2013. 17 Unrevised people and people that were revised 18 subsequent to that do not qualify, and we will 19 continue to press their situations forward. 2.0 The website, which is 21 www.ASRhipsettlement.com, sets forth all the 22 relevant terms. The agreement will shortly be up 2.3 on that website, the full agreement. 24 And then for everyone's benefit sometime

- 1 in the next two weeks I'm going to actually set up
- 2 a Plaintiffs only meeting where I go through the
- 3 actual terms and help answer questions that people
- 4 may have about what the terms actually are.
- 5 But that's generally where things are
- 6 at.
- 7 Kind of the key dates are January 6 of
- 8 2014, Plaintiffs lawyers need to file a document
- 9 that essentially is registering --
- 10 THE COURT: Go ahead. I'm sorry.
- 11 MR. FLOWERS: Essentially registering all of
- 12 their cases, and that doesn't have any obligation
- 13 to participate. It just allows us to have
- 14 information on the total number of cases that are
- out there, revised cases. And there's an actual
- 16 form that will be on the website.
- 17 There is an order that I think you will
- 18 enter today about that registration and, once
- 19 again, something I can explain in greater detail at
- 20 this meeting. So, that's January 6.
- 21 April 1 is the date, the last date to
- 22 enroll in the program, meaning you want to have a
- 23 client participate in the program.
- The program is first come, first served

- 1 basically. So, if you believe your client is
- 2 wanting to enroll in the program, once you
- 3 understand the terms, the sooner you do that, the
- 4 better, because if you qualify and the program goes
- 5 forth, there will be payments made by DePuy on
- 6 basically a first come, first served basis.
- 7 There's a lot of details to the program,
- 8 which once again will be on the website and I can
- 9 explain at this meeting. I don't know if it's
- 10 worthwhile to do it.
- 11 Anyone that also would like a copy of
- 12 the transcript from the hearing last week in
- 13 Toledo, a lot of that documentation about the terms
- 14 were in that as well, which defines some of it, and
- 15 the agreement will be on the website as I
- 16 mentioned.
- MS. SHARKO: So, the transcript from the MDL
- 18 hearing is on the website or will be shortly and
- 19 the transcript from the New Jersey hearing last
- 20 week is or will be on the website shortly.
- 21 The official website is actually
- 22 www.USASRsettlement.com. That's real important
- 23 because there are a number of rogue websites out
- there that many of which contain misleading

- 1 information. There is only one official website,
- 2 which is the USASRhipsettlement.com.
- 3 THE COURT: All right. Let's do it one more
- 4 time because now I have heard it four different
- 5 ways this morning.
- And I will have this, just so everyone
- 7 knows, in the Circuit Court, on my website it will
- 8 have this and a link to it. Okay.
- 9 But I didn't mean to interrupt any of
- 10 you, but I have heard four different websites so
- 11 far. Let me ask you and then if yes and everybody
- 12 can write down the right one.
- 13 www.USASRhipsettlement.com.
- MS. SHARKO: Hip -- yes. That's correct.
- 15 THE COURT: Okay. Thanks. I'm sorry. Go
- 16 ahead.
- 17 MS. SHARKO: That's correct.
- 18 THE COURT: I just wanted to get the right one
- 19 out there.
- MS. SHARKO: That's correct. This is the only
- 21 settlement program. There won't be settlements
- 22 outside of this program. Signing up is, as
- 23 Mr. Flowers said, a two-step process.
- We need everybody to register according

- 1 to the registration order so that everyone knows
- 2 the universe of cases and then a claim form and an
- 3 enrollment form will be up shortly and we urge
- 4 everyone to fill out the claim form and enroll as
- 5 soon as possible because the sooner you get your
- 6 claim form in, the administrator is going to
- 7 process those claims as they come in. So, once the
- 8 settlement is funded, checks can be written.
- 9 THE COURT: Okay. Anything else anybody wants
- 10 to tell me?
- 11 MR. FLOWERS: The only other thing, your
- 12 Honor, is we were asking for an order, CMO No. 5,
- 13 to be entered today, which is an order for the
- 14 appointment of the Plaintiffs' Settlement Oversight
- 15 Committee.
- 16 That is a group of lawyers, including
- myself, that are involved in the process to make
- 18 sure that everything goes according to plan
- 19 especially in part B of the resolution, which
- 20 involves injuries that are more than just a
- 21 revision with a good recovery.
- 22 And the -- our group, meaning all
- 23 lawyers from around the country, have essentially
- 24 agreed upon this group. This order has already

- 1 been entered in the MDL and in New Jersey.
- 2 THE COURT: Okay. I will sign that order.
- 3 MS. SHARKO: Thank you.
- 4 MR. FLOWERS: Thank you.
- 5 THE COURT: And so this is a private
- 6 settlement. I understand that. But I just want to
- 7 say I will be there to help you in any way I can.
- 8 But this has been an outstanding
- 9 pleasure for the Court, and what I have seen of the
- 10 settlement is fair and everybody worked
- 11 tremendously hard to do it with outstanding lawyers
- 12 and I can't thank you enough. This is the way it
- 13 should work and you did a wonderful job. Thank
- 14 you.
- MR. FLOWERS: Thank you.
- MS. SHARKO: Thank you.
- 17 THE COURT: But anything you need, I'm here.
- 18 Pick another status date. Everybody out there
